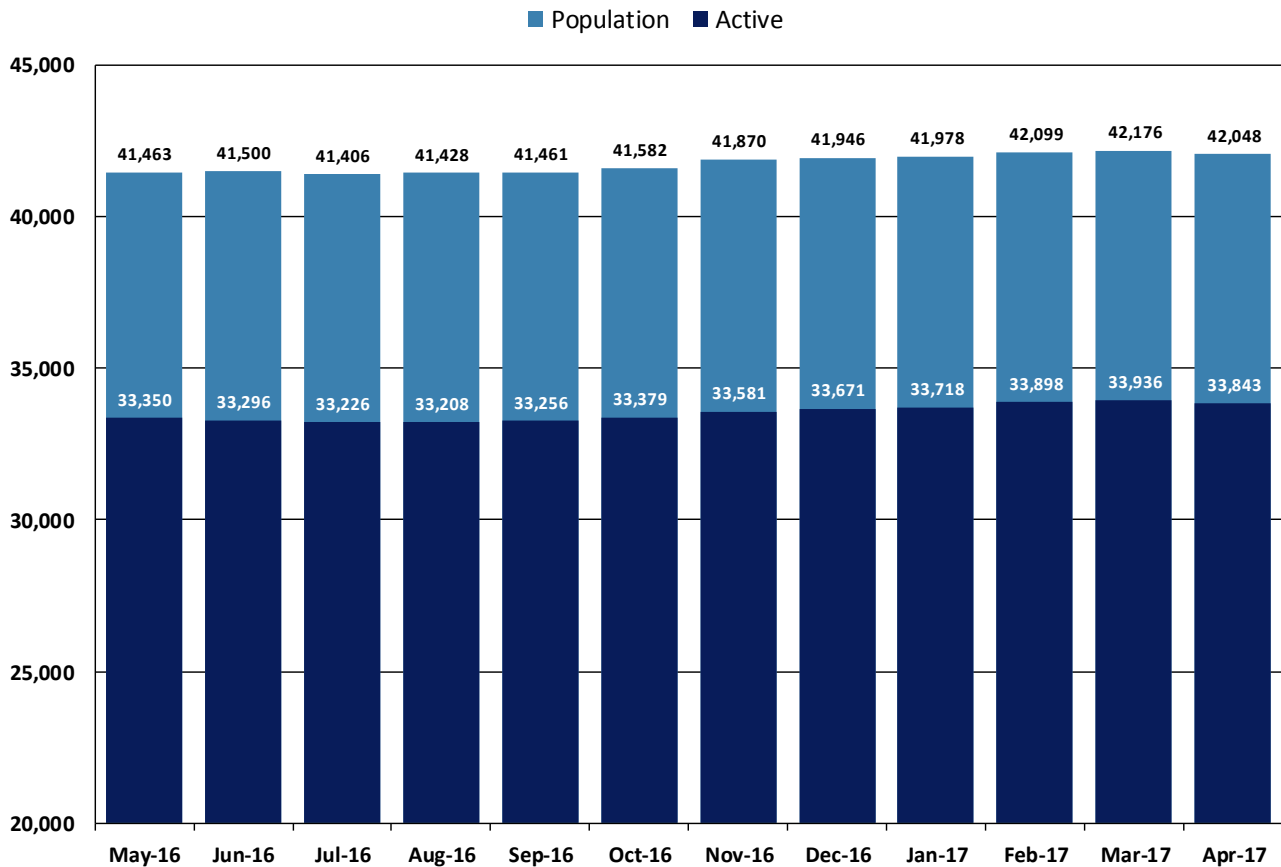

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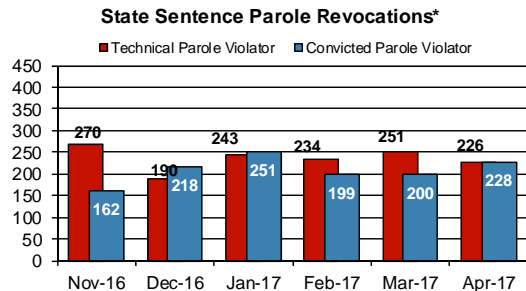
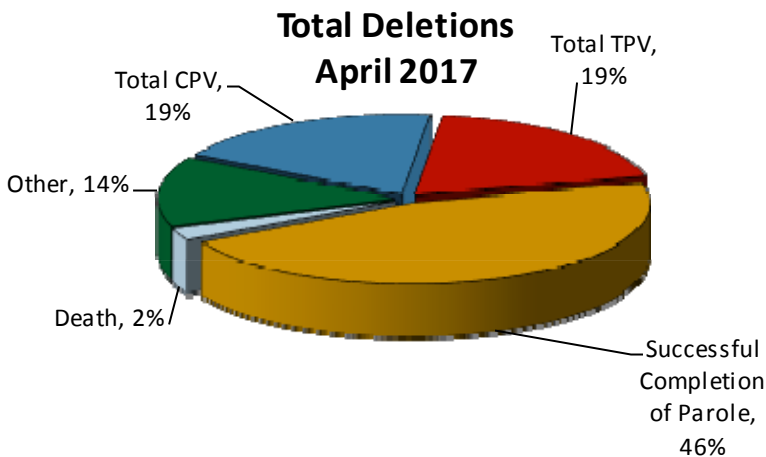
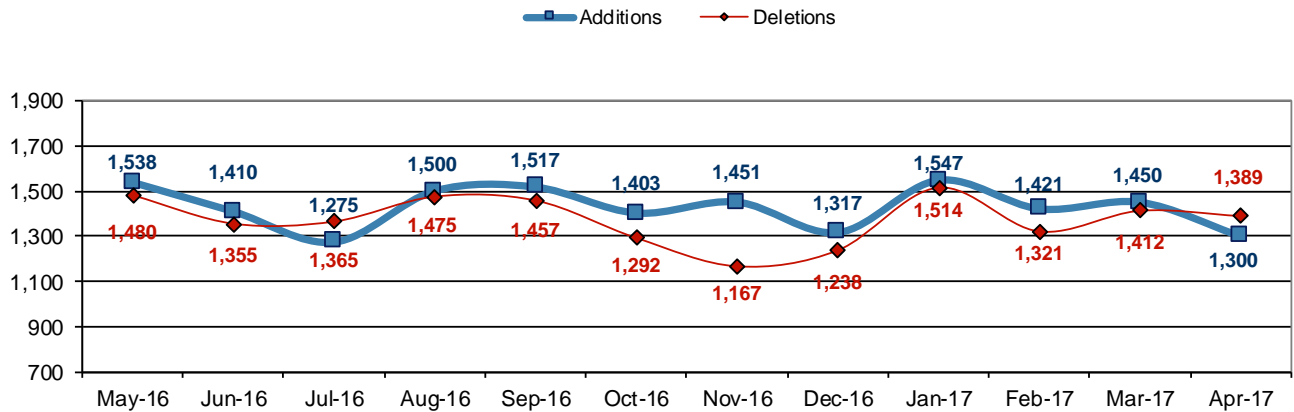
**Population - Retrospective Year View**

**Population Additions & Deletions-Retrospective Year View**

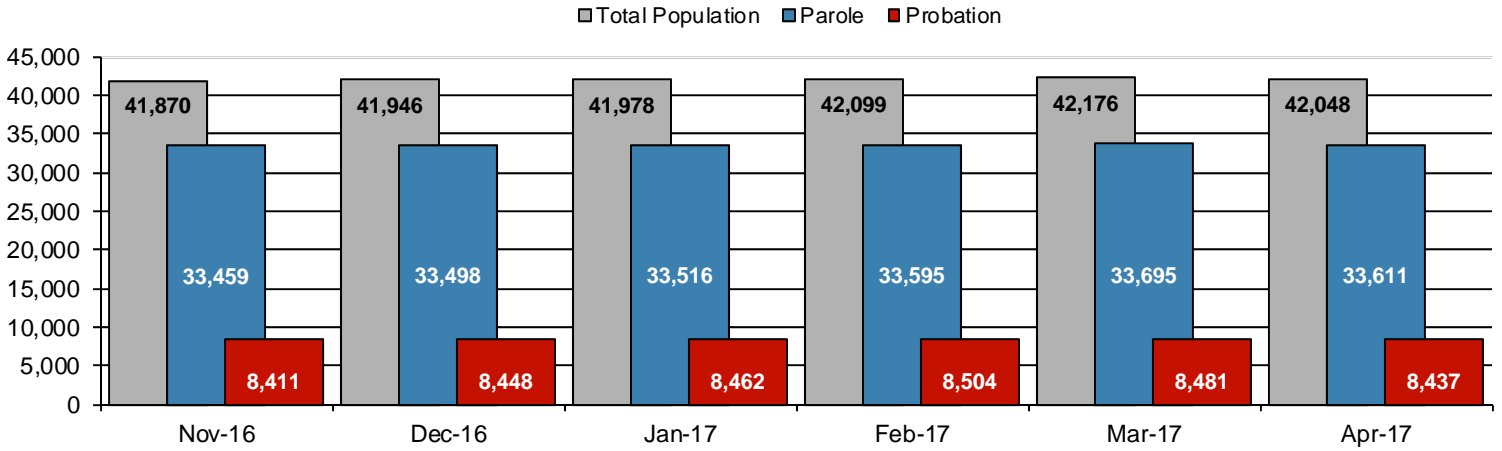

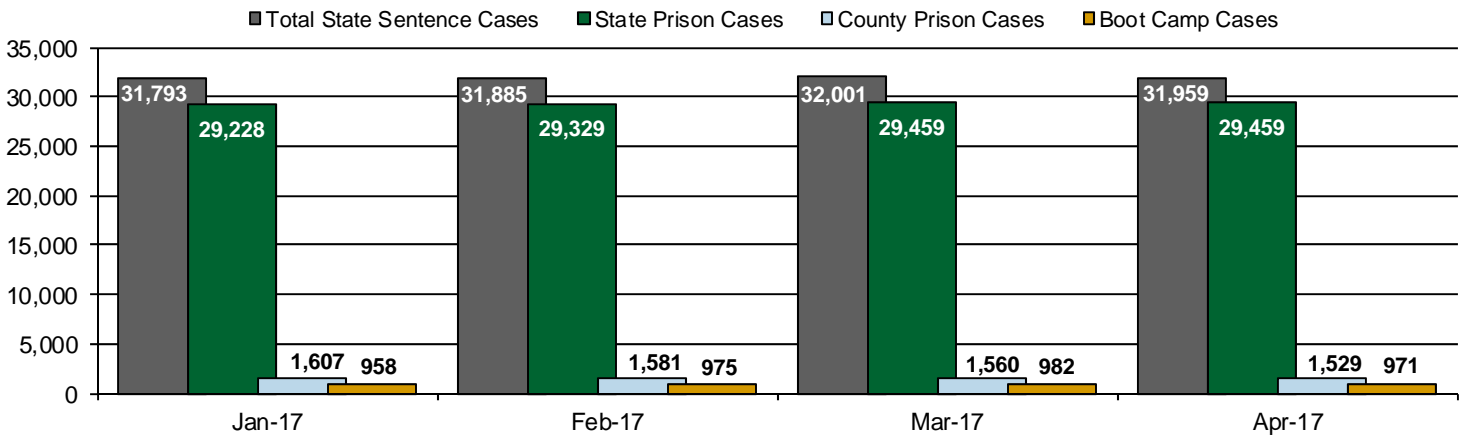

**Parole and Probation Supervised Populations**



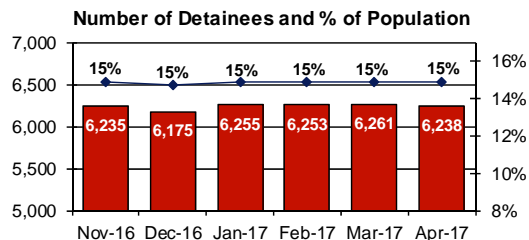
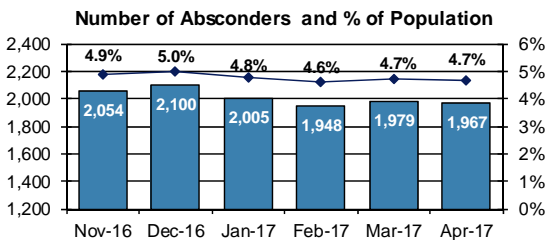
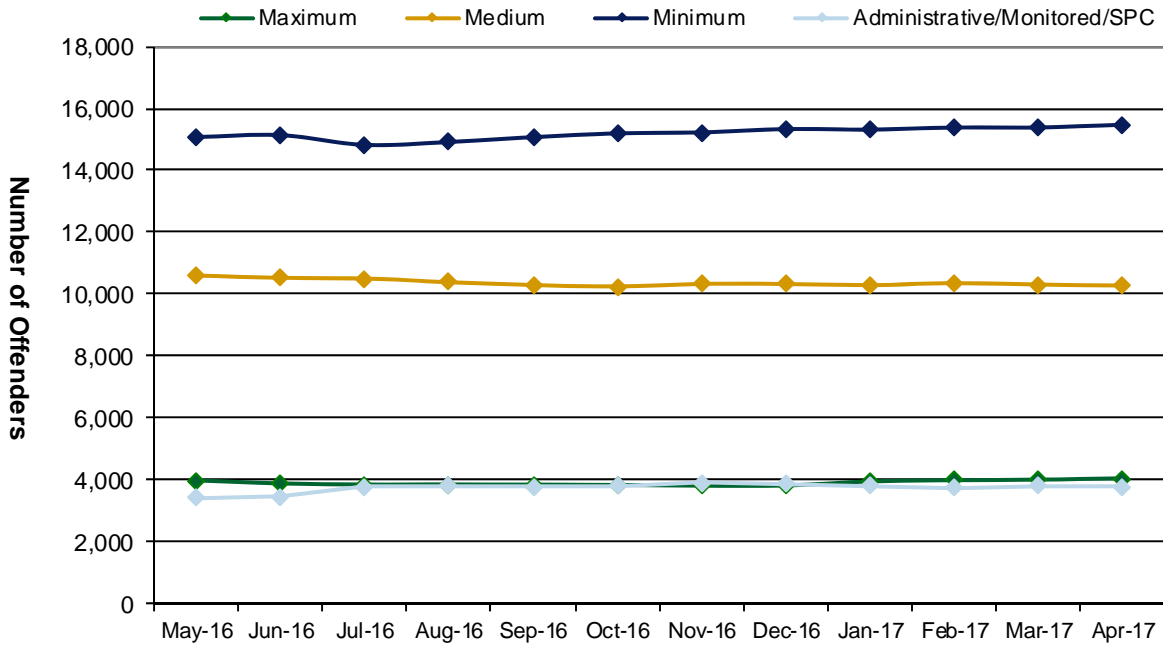

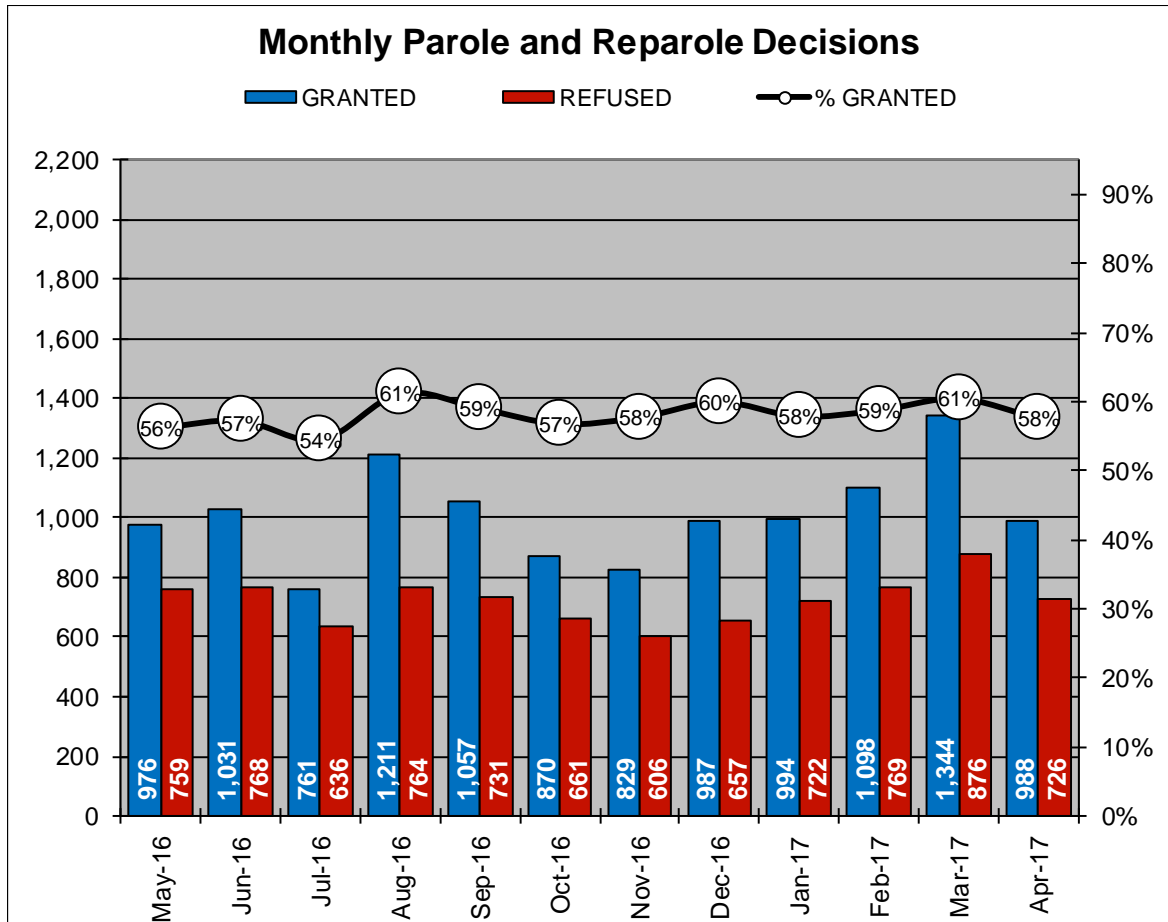

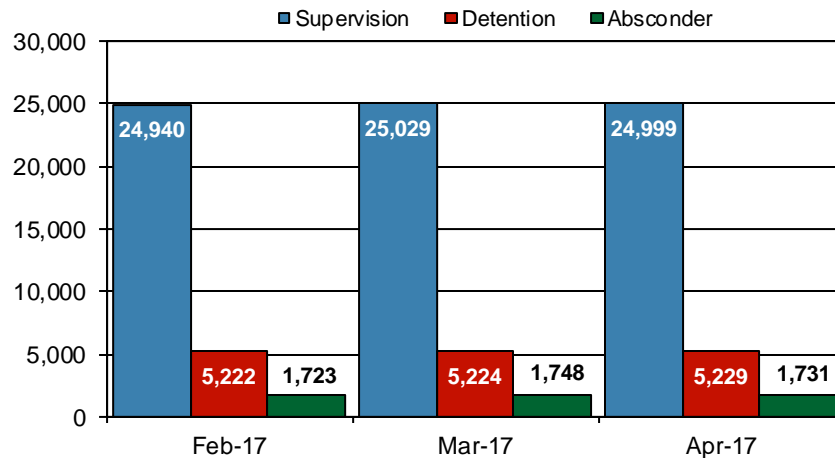

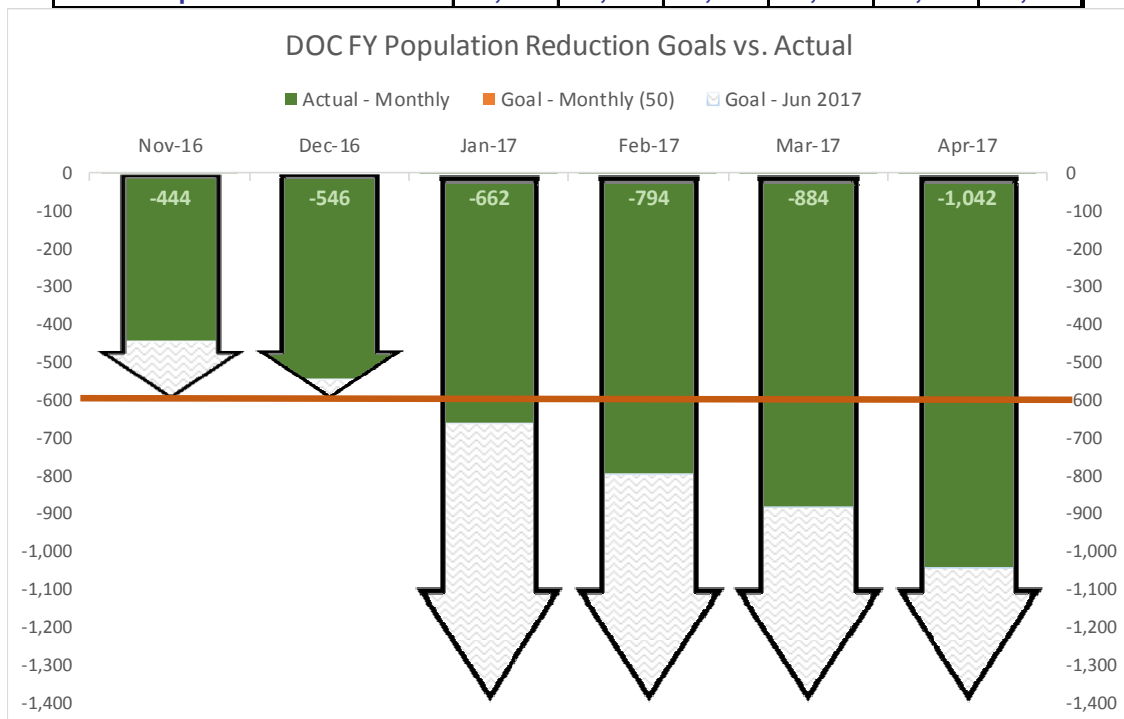
