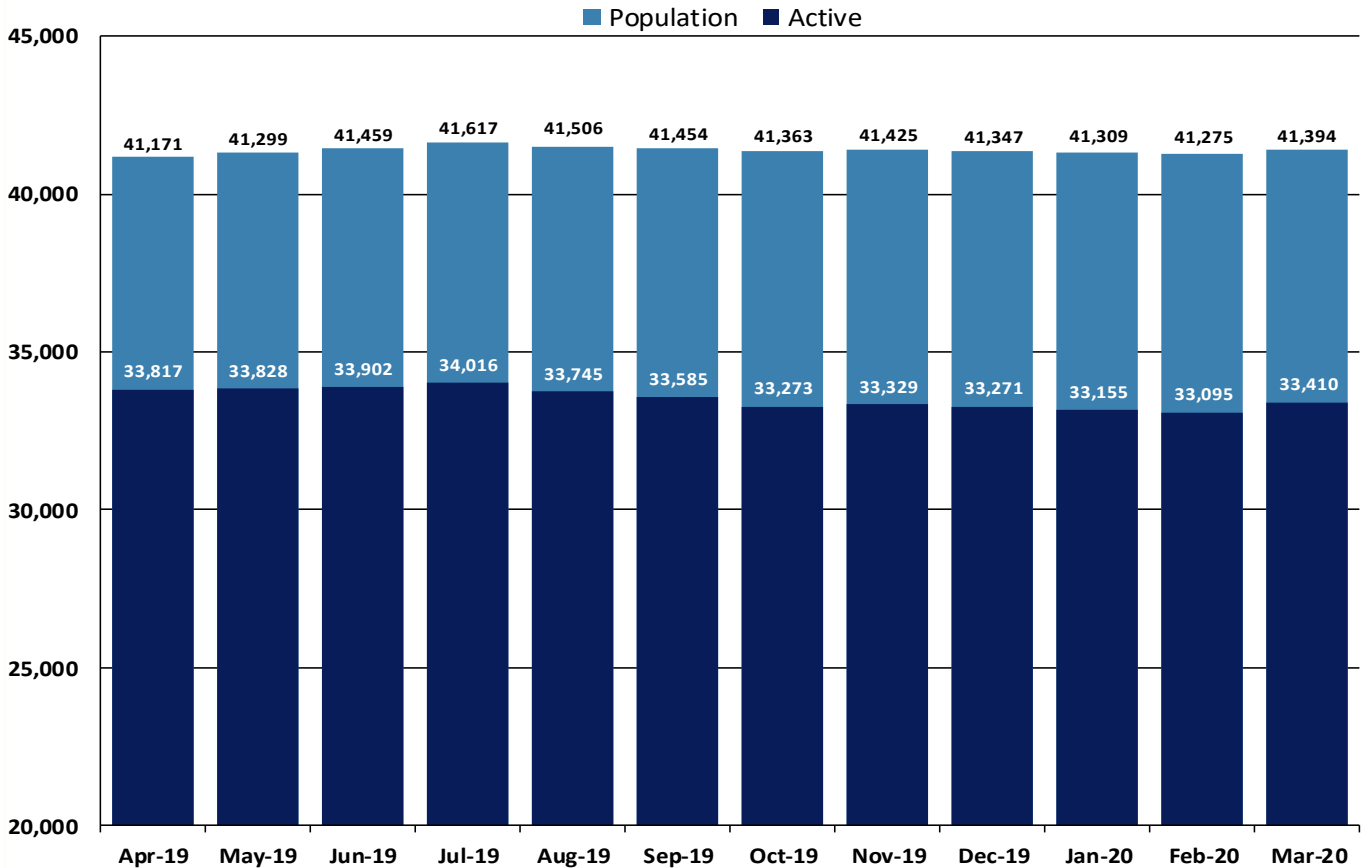

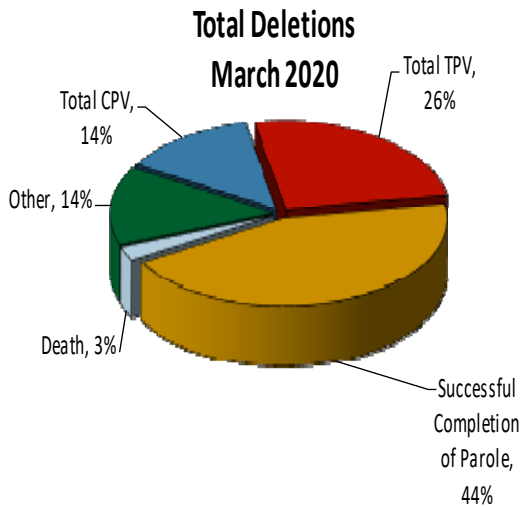
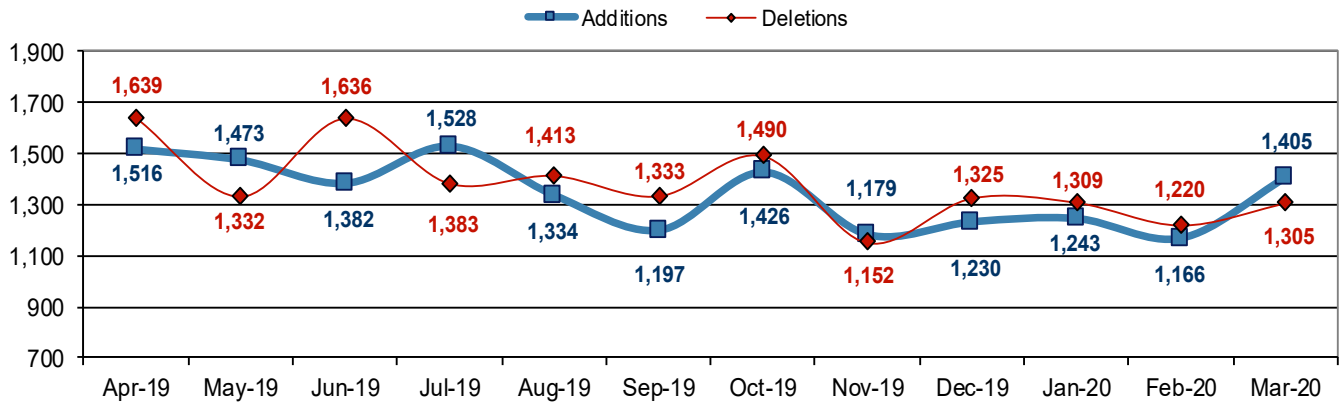
**Population - Retrospective Year View**



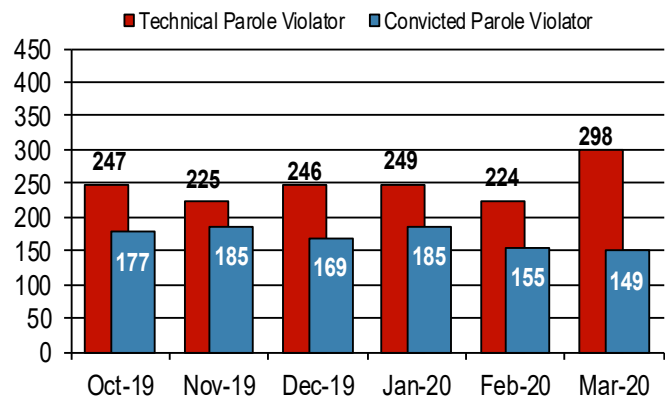

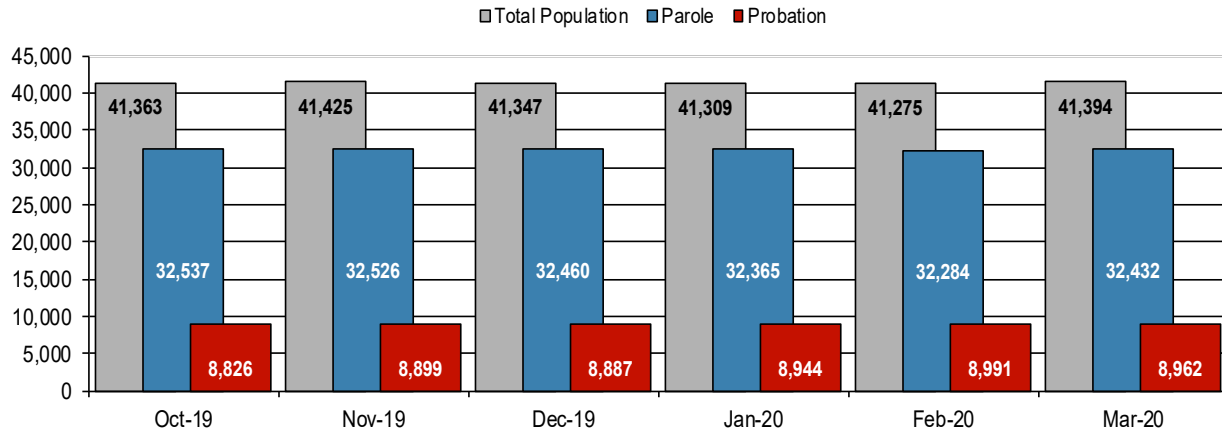

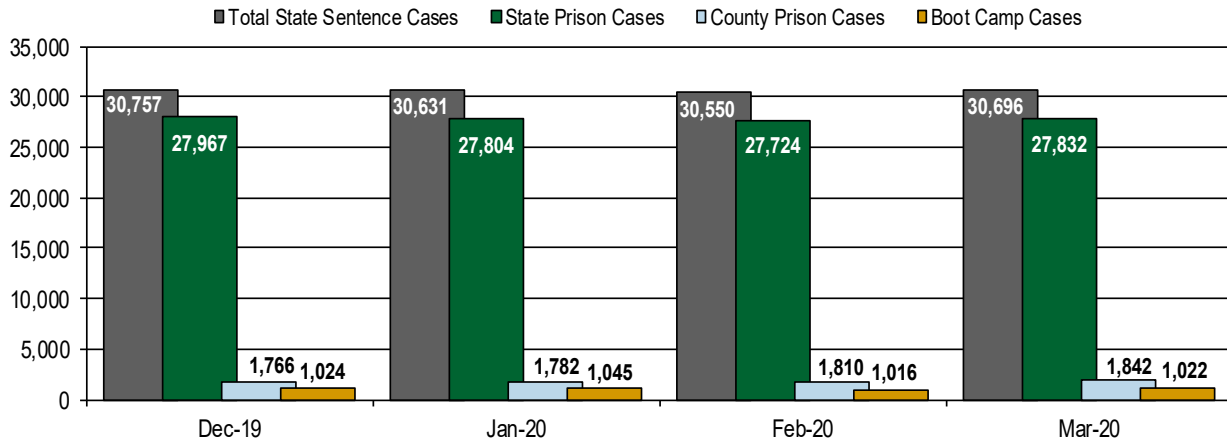

**Parole and Probation Supervised Populations**



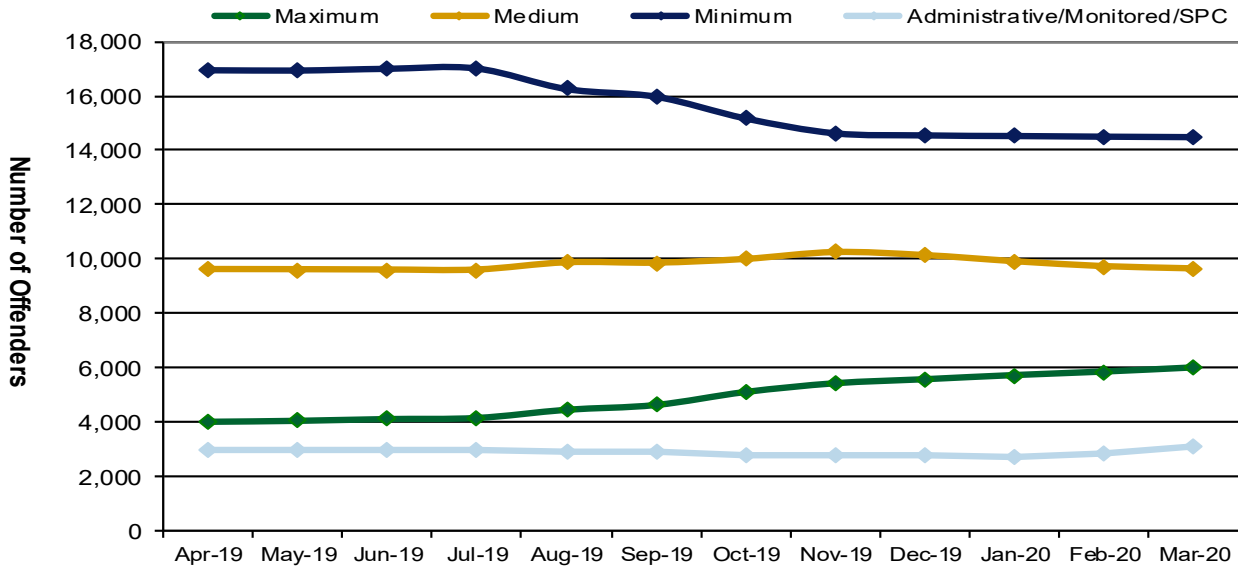
**Supervised State Sentence Cases**



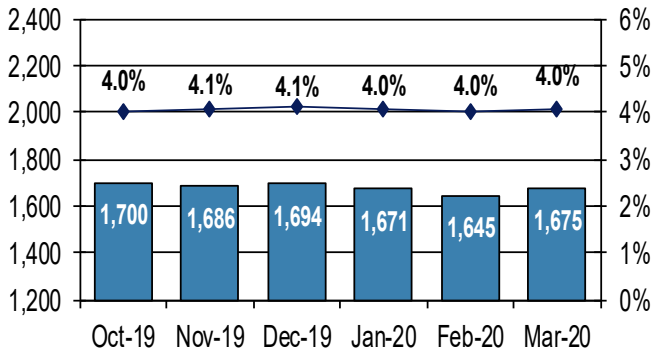

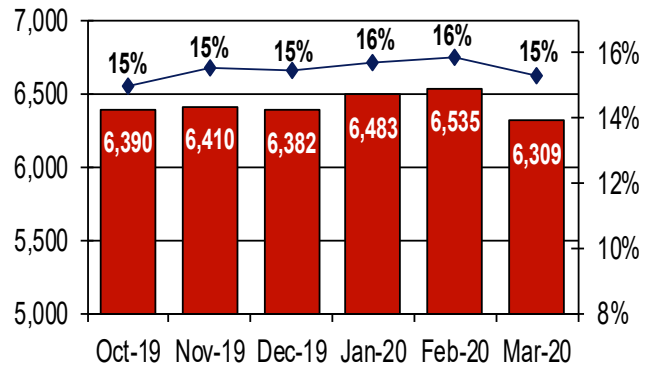
**PBPP Active Cases By Supervision Level**

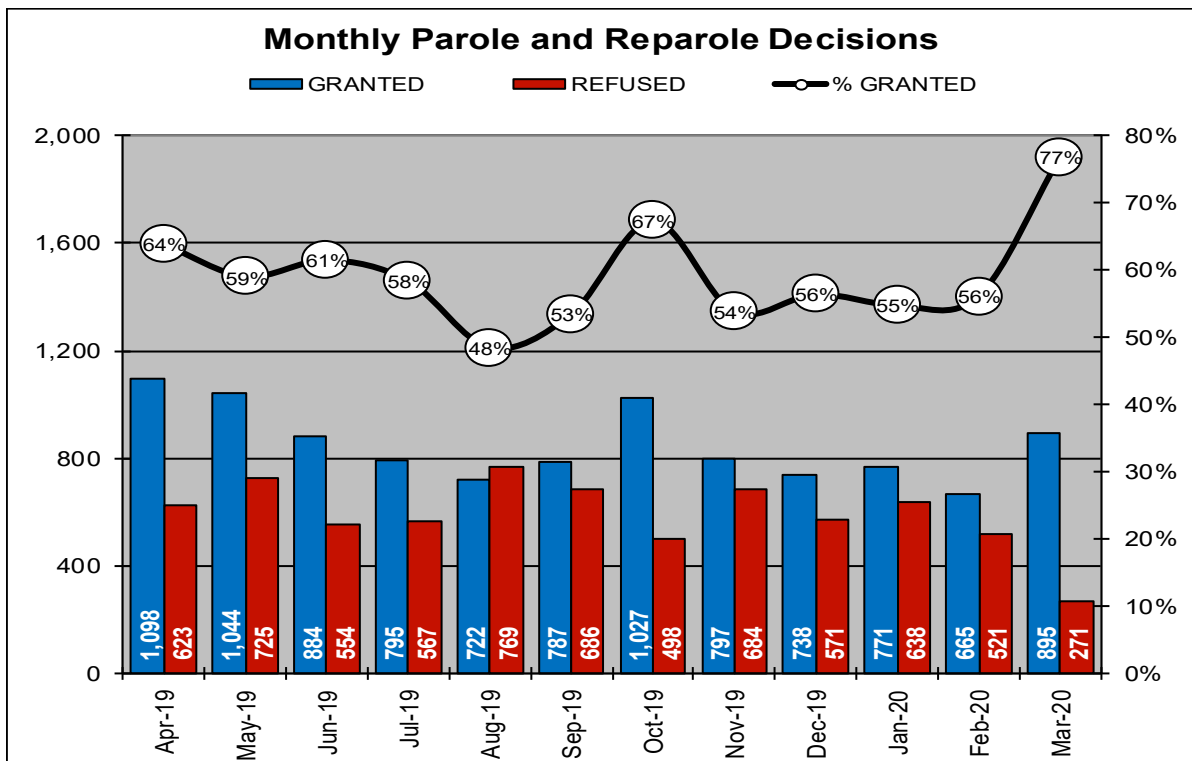

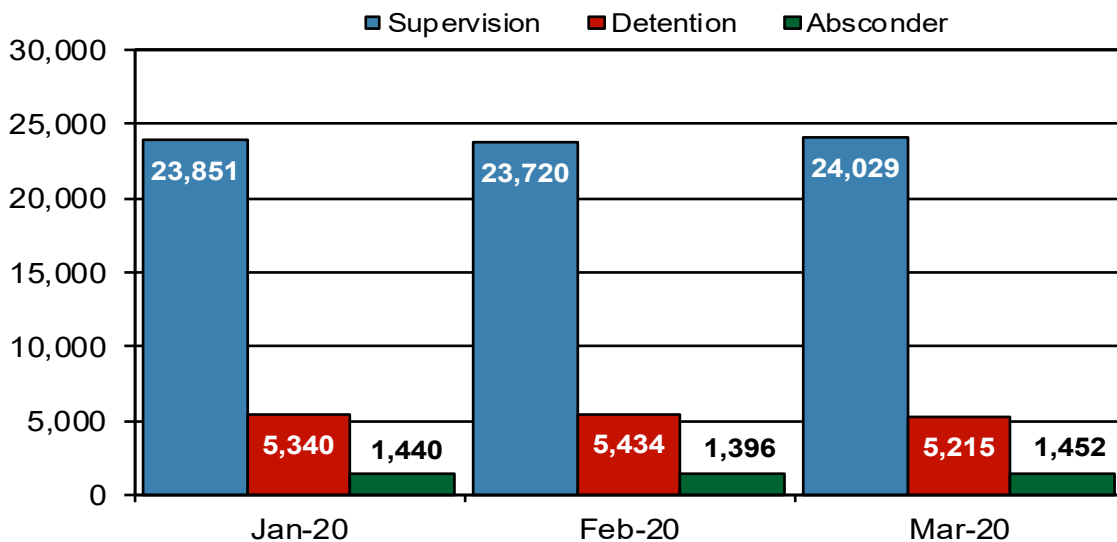

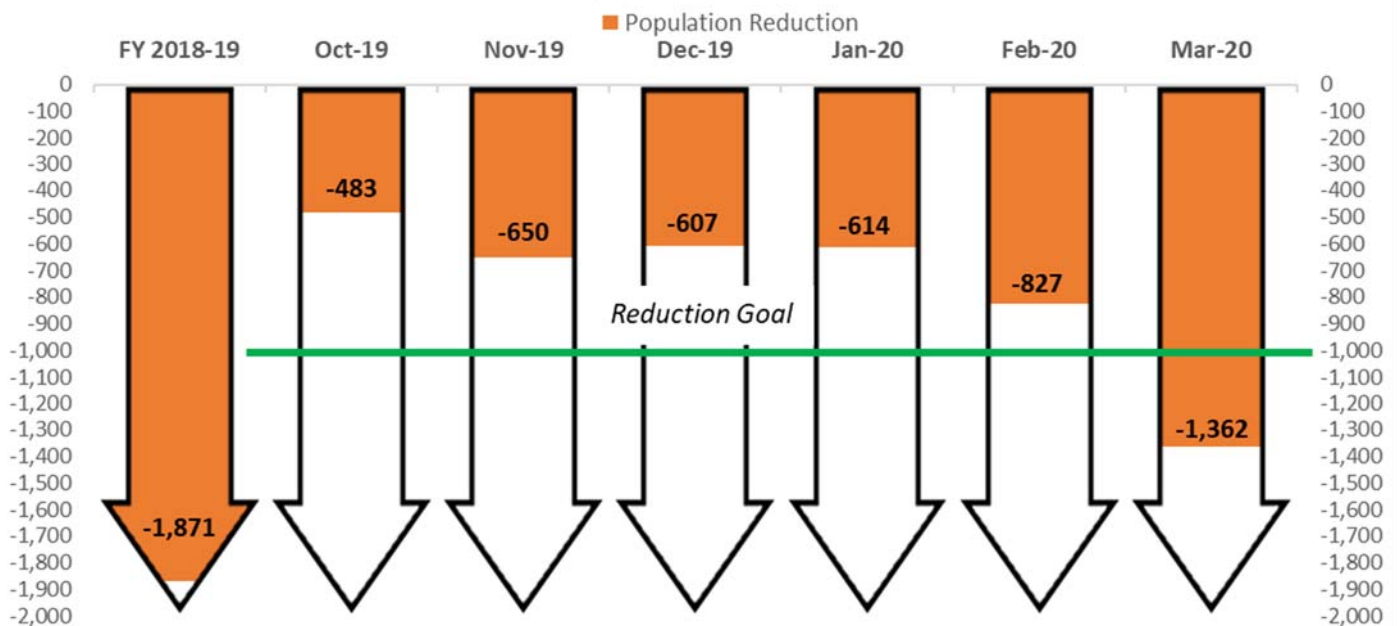
### State Sentence Cases by Offender Status
